MidTown's board committee structure is designed to engage board member participation in an area of personal interest. Committees will meet and undertake project assignments on an *ad hoc* basis and at the discretion of the committee chair.

Executive Committee...will advise the executive director, act on behalf of the full board of directors during on-demand activities that occur between regularly scheduled meetings and present their recommendations to the full board for review and approval.

Community Outreach Committee/Neighborhood Engagement

The Community Outreach Committee will develop and implement programs and initiatives that further MidTown's mission of sustaining and enhancing neighborhoods and businesses in support of community, conservation and diversity. This committee may plan and implement pop-up social events, walks, bike rides, neighborhood and school recognition and programs.

Economic Development Committee

The Economic Development Committee works to identify underutilized MidTown properties and envisions their future use; and to identify potential investors, developers and business prospects and work with them to insure continued business growth and revitalization within MidTown.

Finance/Institutional Advancement Committee

The Finance and Development Committee works to insure MidTown, Inc.'s financial stability, sustainability and accountability, including the cultivation of donors and MidTown Mingle sponsors.

MidTown Business Association (MBA)

The MBA works to sustain, promote and grow business within MidTown Columbus. Annual dues from member businesses support joint marketing efforts and the mission of MidTown, Inc. to sustain and enhance businesses and neighborhoods.

MidTown Mingle...works to ensure the success of this signature MidTown event as both a friend-raiser and fundraiser. They also coordinate sponsorship solicitation with the Institutional Advancement Committee.

Nominating Committee (Executive Committee)

The Nominating Committee, chaired by the Immediate Past President, seeks, screens and recommends potential candidates—representative of MidTown's diversity and with a commitment to furthering the mission of MidTown, Inc.— to serve as members of the board of directors.

Projects/Connections/Active Transportation Committee

Identifies, researches, advises and helps implement projects that further MidTown Inc.'s mission within the community. It may work in conjunction with other committees, especially Economic Development and Community Outreach.
