

Sunday, April 26, 2026 - Lakebottom Park, Columbus, Georgia, Noon to 5 pm

Thank you for your interest in participating in Arts in the Park 2026. This is an Artisan Vendor Show featuring original, handcrafted works. We are seeking art vendors who create artisan items, various forms of artwork, or supply materials used in art creation. All items sold at Arts in the Park should be designed or crafted by you or by a local/regional artisan you represent.

We review applications as they are submitted for approval. The cap for 2026 is 100 vendors.

We will not consider your application if it is not complete. All applications are due by March 29, 2026. We will begin reviewing and accepting vendors *as they apply*.

Vendor categories include, but are not limited to, Painting, Sculpture, Photography, Printmaking, Drawing, Ceramic Art, Woodwork, Jewelry, Mixed-Media Arts, Textiles, and Digital Art.

The event is free for the public.

We had an estimated 3,000 attendees in 2025.

GUIDELINES & APPLICATION

All applications are due by March 29, 2026. However, we will begin reviewing and accepting vendors as they apply. We anticipate that we will sell out before this date. A \$15 late fee will be charged for all applications submitted after that date.

Once approved, you should pay your vendor fee within **FIVE** days. You are not guaranteed your spot until payment is received.

VENDORS: ARTS IN THE PARK is limited to 100 vendors. Each vendor is responsible for its own display needs (including canopy, chairs, tables, etc.). You are responsible for cleaning up your area, removing your trash, and collecting money and applicable sales tax for your business sales.

NO vendor will be allowed to leave before the designated end of the event without prior approval from the Event Chairman.

For the safety of our patrons, once the show has begun, vendors will NOT be allowed to drive their vehicles into the park's interior or move their vehicles around within the park until after the show concludes at 5:00 p.m.

LOCATION: Arts in the Park will be held between the Bandshelter and the Midtown Red Frame on the 18th Avenue side of Lakebottom Park

EVENT DATE: April 26, 2026, from 12 noon to 5:00 pm. There will not be a Rain date in 2026.

SPACE SIZE: All spaces are 10' X 10'. Please indicate the number of spaces needed on the application, up to three (3).

FEES: One 10x10" Vendor Space - \$65.00 (non-refundable). There is no discount for additional booth spaces.

Please note:

RAIN DATE: If the event is rained out, there will be no rain date. We will closely monitor the situation in the days leading up to the event and notify all vendors if it is canceled.

ELECTRICAL: There is **no** access to electricity or water sources.

REFUND: There are no vendor fee refunds for any reason.

PARTICIPATION: Set up begins at 9:30 am. We ask that all vendors remove their cars and complete their setup by 11:30 am. (Approved vendors will receive communication about their load-in instructions to ensure a smooth process for everyone.)

The setup is only on Sunday.
